RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve Resolutions 10-12 and 10-13 finding the Shasta County 2010 Bicycle Transportation Plan and the City of Redding Bikeway Action Plan 2010-2015 consistent with state requirements and the Shasta County Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).

SUMMARY

The Shasta County 2010 Bicycle Transportation Plan and the Redding Bikeway Action Plan 2010-2015 are complete. Staff recommends that the Board finds them consistent with the California Streets and Highways Code and the RTP.

DISCUSSION

The County and City of Redding bike plans must be accepted by the RTPA in order to qualify for State Bicycle Transportation Account (BTA) funds.

The bike plans are consistent with the RTP and address the required elements in Section 891.2 of the California Streets and Highways Code. Required elements include the following:

1. Estimates of bicycle commuting;
2. Maps and descriptions of existing and proposed bikeways, bike parking and storage, and connections with other transportation modes;
3. Recap of community involvement;
4. Coordination with other plans; and
5. Description of proposed bike projects.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT

The Shasta County Board of Supervisors adopted the Shasta County 2010 Bicycle Transportation Plan on June 29, 2010. The Redding City Council adopted the Bikeway Action Plan 2010-2015 on June 15, 2010. The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) concurs with the staff recommendation.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Accepting the bike plans will allow the County of Shasta and City of Redding to apply for BTA grant funds.

WHEREAS, a public review and comment period was provided from May 7 to June 7, 2010; and

WHEREAS the County wishes to promote and encourage bicycle transportation opportunities and obtain funding to construct necessary facilities.

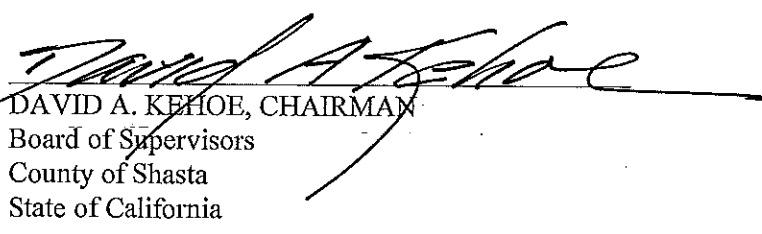
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta makes the following findings:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta adopts the Shasta County 2010 Bicycle Transportation Plan.

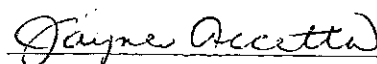
