Appoint Members to the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC)	12/12/06	4-3

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Agency:

- 1) Appoint two new members to the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC); and
- 2) Re-appoint seven current members to three-year terms.

SUMMARY

In order to comply with the California Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 99238, the RTPA is required to have a minimum nine-member SSTAC. Seven of the existing members' three-year terms are up and need to be reappointed for three-year terms.

DISCUSSION

The SSTAC is an active committee that is required by state law to make annual recommendations concerning unmet transit needs. California PUC Section 99238 requires the SSTAC to consist of specific members of the community who are disabled, elderly, of limited means, or social services agencies that provide for those who are disabled, elderly or of limited means. Members are appointed by the Agency for one to three-year terms. New members receive one-year terms.

Lisa White of Shasta Senior Nutrition Programs, representing transit users and senior citizens, and Jane Patterson of Shasta County Opportunity Center, representing social service providers for the disabled, have submitted applications for appointment. Both have actively participated in SSTAC meetings as non-members. The recommended SSTAC roster is attached.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT

The SSTAC and the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) supports the recommended appointments.

FINANCING

There are no financial impacts associated with appointing citizens to the SSTAC.
