STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Shasta Regional Transportation Agency (SRTA) Board of Directors nominate and elect a chair and vice-chair to serve a one-year term, effective immediately.

DISCUSSION:

Every February the SRTA Board of Directors elects a chair and vice-chair for the next year. The chair presides at all meetings, serves on the Fiscal and Policy Committee, decides questions of parliamentary procedure, calls special meetings, and performs such other functions and duties as needed. The vice chair performs the duties of the chair in the chair's absence.

Because the region has only a few local government agencies, SRTA historically rotates chair and vice-chair representation to allow each city, county, and the Redding Area Bus Authority (RABA) to have a representative every four to five years. RABA representatives have also typically been a city of Redding representative. For 2022, Baron Browning (city of Anderson) was chair and Mark Mezzano (RABA/city of Redding) was vice-chair. Past chairs over the last few years are as follows:
