Public hearing closed.

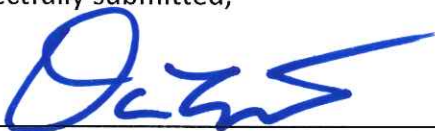
By motion made and seconded (Moty/McArthur), the staff recommendation passed unanimously.
