



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Regarding Regional Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Target Setting And 'Sustainable Communities Strategy'

The Shasta County Regional Transportation Planning Agency (RTPA) and the California Air Resource Board (CARB) are required by Senate Bill 375 to hold a regional workshop regarding the setting of Shasta County's target for household-based vehicle greenhouse gas emissions as a function of regional land use patterns. The RTPA must also host a regional informational meeting regarding the development of a Sustainable Communities Strategy (SCS) for achieving said target.

State funding for transportation and other programs critical to Shasta County will be predicated on progress toward the CARB-assigned target. A combined regional workshop to discuss the target-setting process and local/regional compliance will be held at the next Shasta County RTPA board meeting:

CARB representatives will provide a brief presentation regarding the target setting process. Shasta County RTPA staff will present the Agency's SCS approach. Elected officials from all local agencies and the general public are strongly encouraged to attend and provide comment.
