	Question	Answer
1	Is proposal submittal via email to srts@srts.ca.gov acceptable, or is a hard copy also required to the listed address? If hard copy is required, how many copies?	Submittal by email is acceptable at: srta@srta.ca.gov . A hard copy is not required but may be submitted at the discretion of the consultant. Proposals must be received by 5 PM on March 23, 2021. Postmark dates are not acceptable.
2	Are the 35 pages stated for the page limit single or double sided?	If submitting by hardcopy, then it would be double sided. However, please keep in mind that the maximum page number remains 35, and "pages" does not mean "sheets of paper."
3	Is Section 5 of Proposal Contents- specifically the list of all ATP applications completed- for the prime consultant only, or should it include any subconsultants, if applicable?	The list should include ATP application work completed by both primary and subconsultants. The work need not have been performed as a team. Please identify which consultant worked on which ATP applications, what that work entailed, and a description of the project.
4	May vendors from foreign countries submit bids?	Yes.
5	Please provide us with the list of Items, Schedule of Requirements, Scope of Work, Terms of Reference, Bill of Materials required.	Some of the requested information sounds more like contents of a construction project. This project does not include construction. The other information can be found in the Request for Proposals.
6	Please provide us with the Soft Copy of the Tender Document through email.	A request for proposals was used for this project. A soft copy may be downloaded on SRTA's Bid Postings webpage: https://www.srta.ca.gov/bids.aspx?bidID=59
7	Please provide us with the names of countries that will be eligible to participate in this tender.	All countries should be eligible, but consultants with local knowledge will receive higher scores.
8	Please provide us with Information about the Tendering Procedure and Guidelines	Bidding procedures and guidelines can be found in the Request for Proposals.
9	Please provide us with the Estimated Budget for this Purchase.	This information is included in the Request for Proposals.
10	Will there be any extension of bidding deadline?	Not at this time.
11	Will there be any addendum or pre-bid meeting minutes?	Not at this time.
12	We request you to add our name to your bidder's list and do inform us about upcoming Projects, Tenders.	We would be happy to add you to our list of potential vendors. This list is categorized by services required. Please let us know which services your organization renders.
