

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT
ON THE
DRAFT 2016 SHASTA
REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Shasta Regional Transportation Agency (SRTA) is required to prepare and adopt a 2016 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) outlining priorities for using State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) funds over the next five years. Projects considered include Phase I of the Interstate 5 Redding to Anderson Six-Lane Project (\$12.122M); the Diestelhorst to Downtown Non-Motorized Improvements (\$400K); the Browning Street Complete Streets Project (\$275K); and Planning, Programming and Monitoring funding for SRTA (\$570K).

The draft RTIP is available for review on SRTA's website: www.srta.ca.gov. A hard copy is also available for review at SRTA's office location indicated below. The RTIP will be considered by the SRTA Board of Directors for adoption on Tuesday, December 8, 2015, at 3:00 PM, at which time a public hearing will be held. The meeting will be held at the City of Anderson Council Chambers, 1887 Howard St., Anderson.
