SUBJECT:	Authorize Agreement for Aerial Imagery Procurement

SUMMARY:

Aerial imagery is used in a variety of local and regional planning processes. Imagery for the area encompassing the cities of Shasta Lake, Anderson, and Redding was last obtained in 2010. Up-to-date imagery is needed to reflect the latest land use, transportation, and environmental conditions. SRTA would like to acquire new aerial imagery in partnership with local agencies and organizations.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the board of directors authorize the executive director to enter into a technical services agreement (attached) with *///contractor///* for the *2016 Digital Orthoimagery Collection Project*, a multi-agency aerial imagery procurement, for a term ending _____, not to exceed \$ _____.

DISCUSSION:

The board of directors authorized entering into an aerial imagery agreement with the United States Geologic Survey (USGS) in June 2015. The USGS did not move quickly enough to meet SRTA's and partner organizations' need for "leaf-off and greening" environmental conditions. SRTA staff issued a new request for proposals (RFP) in January to obtain the aerial imagery.

///#/// proposals were received for the aerial imagery procurement and *///#///* were determined to be responsive (attached). It is recommended that *///contractor///* be awarded the *2016 Digital Orthoimagery Collection Project* based on value and relevant experience. (*Note to TAC: Proposals are due by 5:00 PM on February 8, 2016*)

ALTERNATIVES:

The board of directors may award the project to another responsive contractor or reject all the proposals and direct staff to issue a new RFP.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

All three cities, the county of Shasta, the McConnell Foundation, and the Western Shasta Resource Conservation District helped develop the aerial imagery scope and technical specifications.

FINANCING:

\$42,000 is budgeted in the FY 2015/16 Overall Work Program under Work Element 705.02 for aerial imagery. Partners have committed an additional \$90,300 as shown in the following table. The county has committed no funding to the procurement.
